

## **General Tournament Ways to Win**

### **TOP BOAT AWARDS**

Greatest total points accumulated on the final board:  
Custom Top Boat Trophy

### **BIG BOAT OVERALL AWARDS**

(Vessels 26 feet and greater)

Winners determined by total points accumulated on the final board.

1st Place . . . \$2,000 + prizes  
2nd Place . . . \$1,000 + prizes  
3rd Place . . . \$ 500 + prizes

### **SMALL BOAT OVERALL AWARDS**

(Vessels less than 26 feet)

Winners determined by total points accumulated on the final board.

1st Place . . . \$2,000 + prizes  
2nd Place . . . \$1,000 + prizes  
3rd Place . . . \$ 500 + prizes

### **ALL FISH ON FINAL BOARD**

Regardless of vessel size, points, cash and prizes will be awarded to winners in 1st through 6<sup>th</sup> place in each of the six categories on the final board as follows:

1st Place . . . 100 points & \$ 1,000  
2nd Place . . . 90 points & \$ 750  
3rd Place . . . 80 points & \$ 500  
4th Place . . . 70 points & \$ 300  
5th Place . . . 60 points & \$ 200  
6th Place . . . 50 points & \$ 100

Categories include Wahoo, Dolphin, King Mackerel, Tuna, Grouper and Snapper.

All prize money above is based on a 125-boat entry field. If fewer than 125 boats enter, prize money will be adjusted accordingly.

### **LADY ANGLERS AWARD**

The heaviest tournament-legal fish weighed in by a lady angler will earn the angler an engraved plaque and a rod and reel.

### **YOUNG ANGLER AWARD**

**(age 16 and under)**

The heaviest tournament-legal fish weighed in by a young angler will earn the angler an engraved plaque and a rod and reel.

### **FAMILY AWARD**

**(two or more immediate family members)**

The heaviest total of two tournament-legal fish weighed in by a family will earn the family an engraved plaque and a rod and reel.

Anglers must be fishing from the same boat. For purposes of this category, "immediate family members" shall only mean spouses, their children, or siblings, for example, husband/wife, father/son, mother/daughter, or brother/sister.

### **Boat, Motor and Trailer Prize Drawing**

Each boat that brings in an eligible fish over the minimum weight or a release photo of such, receives an entry into the boat/motor/trailer drawing. The fish do not have to appear on the board. (Two fishing days means a chance to receive two entries.) The same rules apply to Inshore Tournament participants. Both inshore and offshore participants will be combined in a single drawing for the boat package at Sunday's awards presentation. The winner must be present to claim the prize. The entrant will have two minutes to claim the prize before another slip is drawn. The winner is responsible for taxes.

**TOURNAMENT WITHIN A TOURNAMENT (TWT) additional WAYS TO WIN if entered  
TWTs are Optional** (10 percent of all TWT will go toward running the tournament)

Winnings under TWT are in addition to the general tournament winnings. Only officially registered entrants in the general tournament may enter the TWT, and only the entrant may claim the winnings at the awards presentation. Entrants of the general tournament must enter a TWT category to be eligible to win in that TWT category. All rules pertaining to the general tournament shall apply to the TWT. Entrants may enter any one or more categories.

**CATEGORY 1**

\$300 ENTRY FEE

OVERALL POINTS WINNERS

All prize money in this category will be paid to the top three boats with the most total points on the final board at the end of the General Tournament:

First-place entrant — 45%

Second-place entrant — 35%

Third-place entrant — 20%

Example:

100 boats entered x \$300 – 10% = \$27,000 up for grabs.

1st place would win \$12,150

2nd place would win \$ 9,450

3rd place would win \$ 5,400

**CATEGORY 2**

\$100 ENTRY FEE

HEAVIEST TROLLING FISH

All prize money will be awarded to the entrant in this category who weighs in the heaviest wahoo, dolphin, king mackerel or tuna during the tournament.

**CATEGORY 3**

\$100 ENTRY FEE

HEAVIEST BOTTOMFISH

All prize money will be awarded to the entrant in this category who weighs in the heaviest grouper or snapper during the tournament.

**CATEGORY 4**

\$100 ENTRY FEE

HEAVIEST TROLLING (SLAM)

All prize money will be awarded to the entrant in this category who weighs the heaviest slam of one fish from each of the wahoo, dolphin, king mackerel and tuna categories during the tournament.

**Entrant does not have to weigh in a fish from all categories to win.**

**CATEGORY 5**

\$100 ENTRY FEE

HEAVIEST BOTTOM (SLAM)

All prize money will be awarded to the entrant in this category who weighs the heaviest slam of one fish each from the grouper and snapper categories during the tournament.

**Entrant does not have to weigh in a fish from all categories to win.**

### **OPTIONAL RELEASE BILLFISH TOURNAMENT**

This will allow FishStock to keep billfish as a category but separate it from the general tournament. By doing so the event will have a billfish category that caters to billfish fishermen only. Each caught and released marlin is worth 300 points, and each caught and released sailfish is worth 100 points. We will provide cameras for participants in this category only.

**No points for this category will count toward the general tournament.**

### **\$300 ENTRY FEE**

The prize money for this tournament will depend on the number of boats participating: The number of boats times the entry fee less 15 percent for cameras equals the total payout. The total payout will be paid as follows:

Entrant in this category with most billfish points scored during general tournament: 45%

Second-place entrant in this category: 35%

Third-place entrant in this category: 20%

To participate in this TWT, you must be entered the general tournament.
