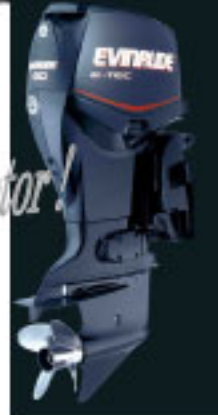

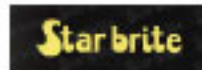

2004 PANAMA CITY OFFSHORE Tournament Rules



ENTRY FEE and REGISTRATION

To encourage early registration, entries received one week prior to Anglers' Party are eligible for a discount. The early registration fee is \$250 through August 5, 2004, and \$300 thereafter. The entry fee covers the boat and all anglers on the boat. On-site registration will be accepted up to Friday, August 13, 2004, at 8:30 p.m. at the registration desk during the Captains' & Anglers' Party at the Panama City Marina. **No entries will be accepted after 8:30 p.m.** Entry fees are not refundable.

There are two methods of entering the tournament. Anglers can mail a completed entry form with a personal check, credit card, or money order payable to: **World Sports Marketing LLC, c/o Panama City OFFSHORE Tournament**, 460 N. Orlando Ave., Ste. 200 Winter Park, FL 32789. They may also hand deliver the same materials to Jim Wilson, tournament director, at the Panama City Marina. The first 250 entry forms received at this address will be accepted for registration. Entry forms received after boat number 250 will be placed on a waiting list in the order received.

This is a boat-registration tournament. At the check-in desk, each boat will be given an identification number to be displayed on the boat. Only officially registered boats can compete in the tournament. Tournament management must approve any boat changes prior to 8:30 p.m. at the Captain's & Angler's Party. Entrant's social security number is required on all applications.

BASIS OF AWARDS

The eligible fish species for the tournament are **wahoo, dolphin, king mackerel, grouper, red snapper and amberjack**; each species constitutes a separate tournament category. Category winners will be for the three heaviest fish totals in each of these categories. A boat/entrant can be a winner in only two (2) places within a category. The boats catching the largest number of eligible species and the greatest total weight will determine the boat champions. Each boat's largest fish caught of each eligible species determines the total weight. For instance, if only one boat has caught six eligible species, they will win the boat award. If two boats have six eligible species, then the boat with the most weight will be the winner, with the other boat assuming the next position. Winners may be subject to polygraph examination. All cash and merchandise will be awarded to the tournament entrant.

TYPES OF AWARDS

Each boat that weighs in a tournament fish over the minimum weight receives an entry into the Cobia boat/Yamaha motor/Performance trailer drawing – one entry, per boat, per day, maximum. The fish do not have to appear on the final board. Cash, trophies and merchandise will be awarded to the top three boats overall, the top three category winners and the motor drawing winner. **The entrant must be present at the awards presentation to receive their award.** Exception due to hardship will be made at the discretion of the tournament management. If an exception is granted, it will be the sole responsibility of the winner to arrange for pickup of all merchandises awards at their own expense within 30 days after the awards presentation.

OPTIONAL TOURNAMENT WITHIN A TOURNAMENT DIVISIONS

Winnings under the optional Tournament Within a Tournament (TWT) divisions are in addition to the general tournament winnings. These are separate tournament divisions available only to participants whose boats are already entered in the general tournament. Only the entrant of the tournament may claim the winnings at the awards presentation held on Sunday. All rules pertaining to the general tournament shall apply to the optional Tournament Within a Tournament (TWT) division. Sign up by mail with your entry or at the optional Tournament Within a Tournament division table at the Captains' & Anglers' Party.

FISHING RULES

This tournament will be fished in accordance with the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission rules for size and catch limits (see: www.floridamarine.org). All participants must fish from the boat. No tournament boat may leave the water before weigh-in unless there is an emergency. All fish must be weighed in on the day caught. All tournament fish must be caught on rod and reel. Any state law or United States federal law that conflicts with these rules shall override these rules, and all anglers are responsible for knowing and abiding by state laws and United States federal laws governing fishing in this tournament. Tournament management reserves the right to modify/change the rules prior to any tournament. All decisions made by the tournament management are final.

All boats must CHECK OUT at the Panama City Marina seawall, beginning at 6 a.m. and ending at 7 a.m. and proceed to fishing locations. Checkout will be single file so your boat number can be recorded. Your boat number determines your position in line for the checkout each morning. Checkout-station personnel will remain on location until 7 a.m. Boats checking out after 7 a.m. MUST contact tournament control and be visually checked-out at the weigh-in station. Fishing hours begin immediately after a boat has checked out with the committee station located at Panama City Marina and end by announcement at 5 p.m. on Saturday, August 14, and 1 p.m. on Sunday August 15, respectively.

The Panama City Marina is the official weigh-in station for this tournament. All fish considered for weigh-in must be recorded in at the official weigh-in station. All fish must be fresh-caught that day. Fish must remain on and be removed directly from the entered boat by weigh-in station personnel. If an angler is fighting a fish hooked prior to 5 p.m. Saturday or 1 p.m. Sunday, they may continue fighting the hooked fish. All boats must be in the weigh-in lines by 6 p.m. Saturday and 2 p.m. Sunday or no fish on such boat will be recorded as a tournament catch on that day. Fishing times are clear. NO FISHING FROM ENTERED BOATS DURING NONFISHING HOURS!

*Every boat must CHECK IN with the tournament check-in personnel at the Panama City Marina seawall to be eligible for weigh-ins. Boats must check in by 6 p.m. Saturday and 2 p.m. Sunday. Once you have checked in, you will remain in the area and wait to be called in to the dock. All boats MUST check in and be acknowledged. If you do not have fish to weigh, you still must check in with the check-in personnel. ANY BOAT THAT DOES NOT CHECK IN CAN BE DISQUALIFIED. Note: Fishing after tournament hours is prohibited. Minimum Wake Zone will be in effect from a quarter (1/4) mile each side of the checkout and check-in boats. **CAUTION: Boats are not allowed to be put on a trailer during tournament fishing hours unless there is an emergency.***

AWARDS PRESENTATION

The tournament awards presentation will be held Sunday, August 15, at 7 p.m. at the Panama City Marina.

EXIT, ENTRY AND CHECKIN

This is a boat-registration tournament. All boats fishing the tournament must leave and return via the weigh station located at Panama City Marina.

REQUIREMENT OF ELIGIBLE FISH

All fish must be of legal weights to be considered in this tournament. All fish must meet the following minimums to qualify for awards.

Wahoo -15 lbs.; **Dolphin** -15 lbs.; **Kingfish**-15 lbs.; **Grouper**-10 lbs.; **Red Snapper**-10 lbs.; **Amberjack**-20 lbs.

REQUIREMENT OF ELIGIBLE FISH, continued.

The weighmaster reserves the right to hold and examine internally and externally any fish weighed in as a tournament catch to determine if the fish is eligible for an award. Any fish that has an unnatural material in or on it will be disqualified.

COMMUNICATIONS RADIO/CELL PHONE

The official tournament channel is 72. All boats must be equipped with a VHF radio or cell phone. The tournament cell phone numbers will be provided at the Captains' meeting. If for any reason VHF Channel 72 is off the air, communications will move to VHF Channel 68 temporarily. Please keep the radio free for daily instructions.

TIES

Boats with fish to weigh will be assigned a number by the official check-in boat. In the event of a point tie within the general tournament, the boat accumulating the points first (with the lowest check-in number) shall be declared the winner of the tie, with second place going to the next lower position in the points standing.

POLYGRAPH

All participants in the tournament are subject to a polygraph at the request of the tournament management. Failure to successfully pass such an examination may result in a test of a second team member; a second failure results in automatic disqualification of the team. This is at the sole discretion of the tournament management.

DISQUALIFICATION

If any boats come together or if anything is passed between boats or docked for any reason after the official start of that day's fishing and before each boat has weighed in, then such boats shall be disqualified for that day. However, as safety is of prime importance to the operation of the tournament, exceptions may be granted by the tournament management for emergencies, but only to boats granting assistance and not to boats receiving assistance in such case.

PROTEST

All protests must be presented in writing to the tournament director at the weigh-in station on the day of the alleged infraction, within one (1) hour after the closing of the weigh-in station. A \$100 cash deposit, refundable if the protest is upheld, must accompany protests. **FishStock** management will make all decisions, and their decision is final. If the protest is not upheld, then such deposit will be forfeited to the tournament.

TACKLE AND EQUIPMENT

Artificial lures, live bait, dead bait, or any combination is permitted in the tournament. Fish must be caught on rod and reel. Electric reels and wire line are not allowed in the tournament.

CHARTER BOATS

Any captain can enter a chartered boat, regardless of where based, by paying the entry fee and following the established registration procedures.

AMENDMENTS

The statement and rules contained herein may be amended by additional verbal instruction and/or printed matter distributed by the tournament management.

WEATHER CONDITIONS

Tournament management reserves the right to terminate a day's fishing because of unsafe conditions. If, due to bad weather, we are unable to fish on Saturday, participants will fish on Sunday, with awards immediately to follow. If Sunday is also not fishable, the event will be postponed until the following Saturday, but the tournament shall be considered complete if one day's fishing is completed, regardless of weather.

SPORTSMANSHIP

All participants will exercise good and courteous sportsmanship whether at the dock, underway, or fishing. Violators will be subject to disqualification without refund.

Grand Prize:

BOAT, MOTOR and TRAILER PRIZE DRAWING

Weigh an eligible fish over the minimum weight and you will have a chance to win a Cobia 184 boat with a 115-hp Yamaha engine and Performance trailer!

Each boat that weighs in a tournament-eligible fish over the minimum weight receives an entry into the boat/motor/trailer drawing. The fish do not have to appear on the final standings board. Entries may be awarded on both Saturday and Sunday, providing a chance to receive two entries, one per boat, per day, maximum. Offshore participants will be combined in a single drawing for the boat package at Sunday's awards presentation. The boat ENTRANT must be present to claim the boat prize. The entrant will have two minutes to claim the prize before another slip is drawn. **The winner is responsible for taxes.**

TOP BOAT AWARDS

This is a cash prize and gift award category, based on 40 percent of the available cash purse. Awards are based on the boats that have caught the most eligible species and total weight. General tournament cash awards are based on total number of entries, less 10 percent. Each boat's largest fish caught of each eligible species determines the total weight. For instance, if only one boat has caught six eligible species, they will be the winners of the boat awards. If two boats have six eligible species, then the boat with the most weight will be the winner, with the other boat assuming the next position. **Example: 50 boats entered at \$250 per boat = \$12,500, less 10% = \$11,250, total available cash purse.**

EVINRUDE TOP BOAT AWARD

A Top Boat trophy and a **90-hp EVINRUDE ETEC** outboard motor will be presented to the top offshore boat responsible for the greatest total species and weight accumulated for wahoo, dolphin, kingfish, grouper, snapper and amberjack. Total weight is made up of the heaviest fish per species. Winners receive 40 percent of the total available cash purse, based on the above example of 50 boats entered. Evinrude Top Boat Award example breakdown as follows:

- 1st Place: 50 percent, or \$2,250, and a prize package, including a **Quantum rod and reel** package, **C-MAP** software and **Costa del Mar** sunglasses.
- 2nd Place: 30 percent, or \$1,350, and a prize package, including a **Quantum rod and reel** package and **Costa del Mar** sunglasses.
